UIS's web services: defining our terms

UIS currently offers two hosted content management systems:

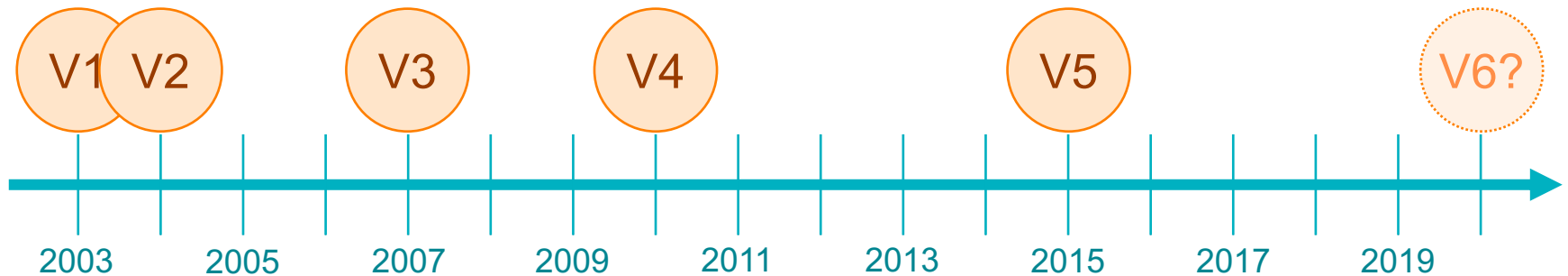



Falcon, which is based on Plone. In this presentation, we'll refer to this as '**Falcon-on-Plone**'.






Drupal. We're developing a new version of the Falcon service based on Drupal. We'll refer to this as '**Falcon-on-Drupal**'.

Falcon-on-Plone is approaching end-of-life



- Falcon is based on the content management system  Plone.
- We are running version 4, which could stop getting official patches in as little as 18 months.
- Migrating to version 5 is a *breaking change*, not a simple upgrade.

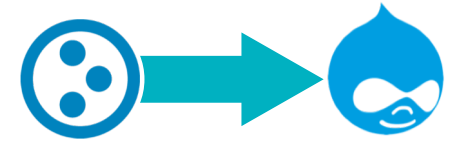

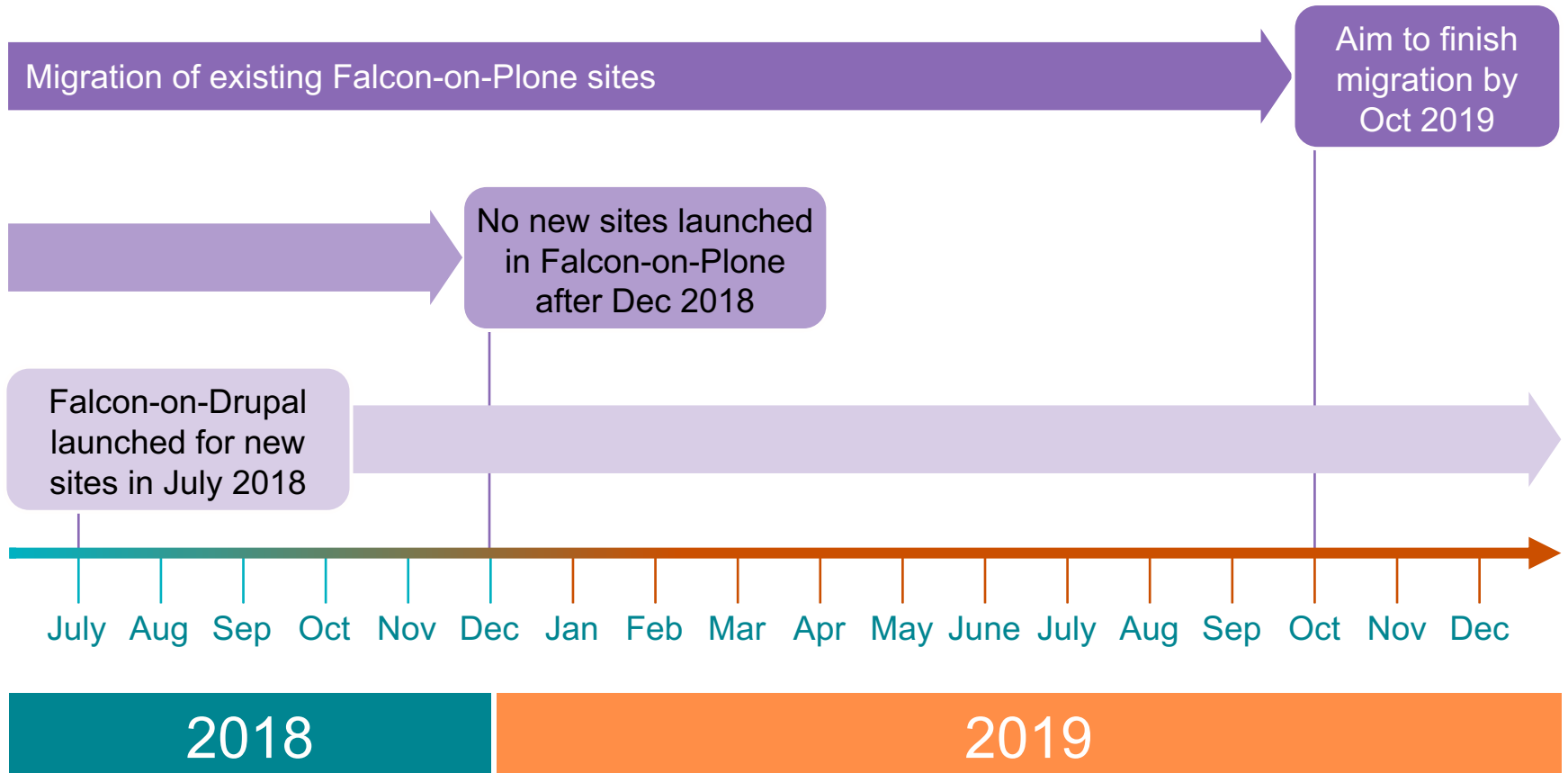


- **Developing training**

- Arranging training with users as part of their site migration

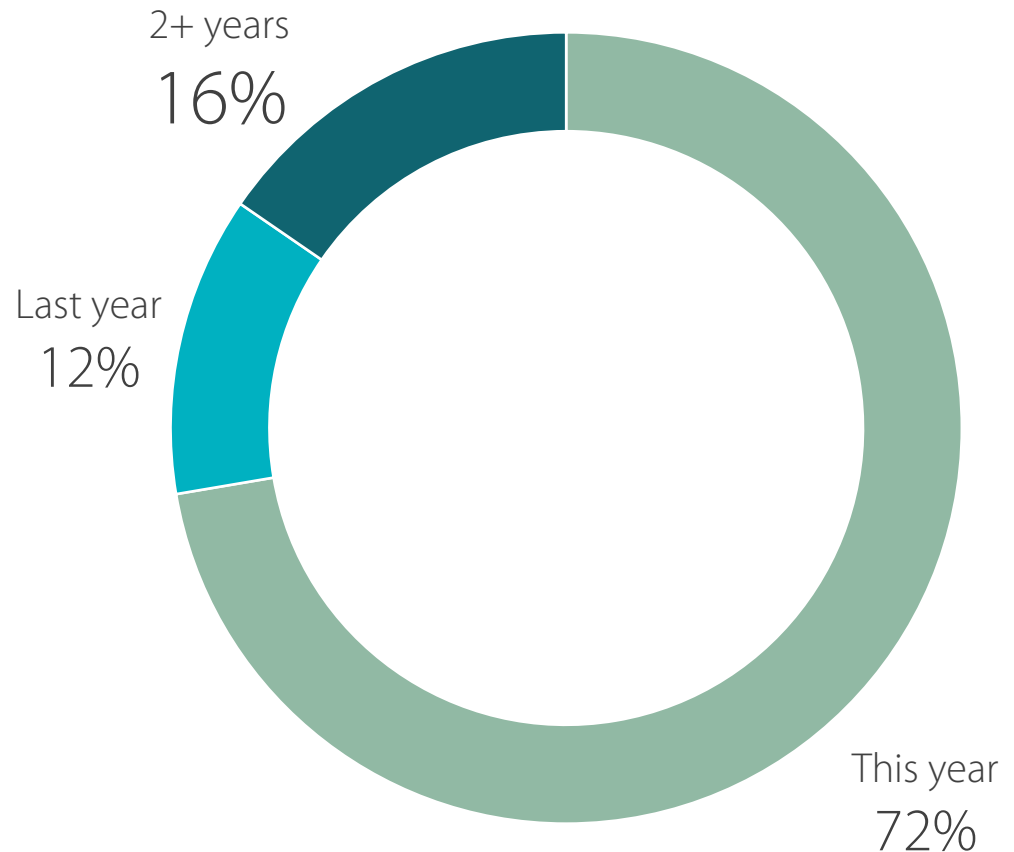


The roadmap

- 16% of Falcon-on-Plone sites haven't been updated in 2 or more years.
